

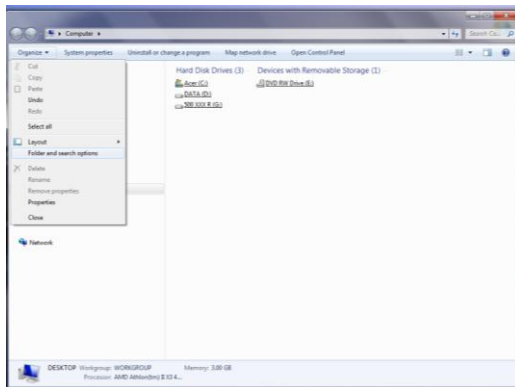
Desktop Backgrounds for Windows 7 users

If you have upgraded to Windows 7 you will have some rather nice UK pictures available as backgrounds but did you know that there are more?

There is a collection of other international scenes hidden away on your computer

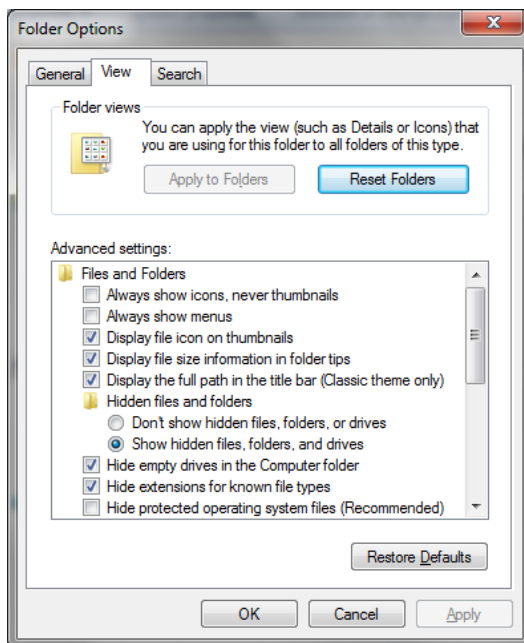
To make these pictures available you first need to “unhide” them. Follow these instructions carefully –

1. Open “Window Explorer” or “Computer”
2. Click the “Organise” button
3. Click the “Folder and search options”



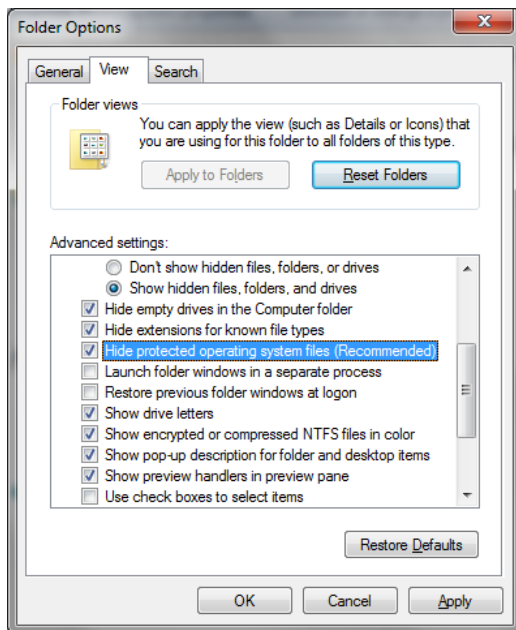
then the “View” tab

4. Scroll down until you see “hidden files and folders” and make sure that the “Show hidden files, folders and drives” is ticked

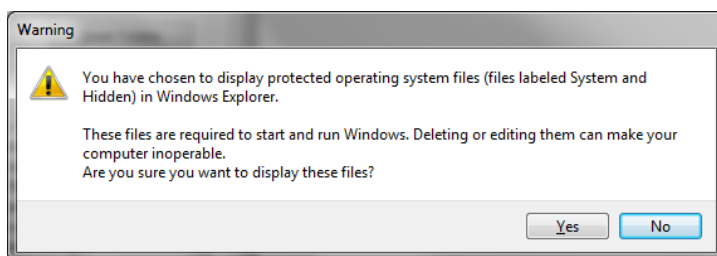


5. Scroll down further until you see “Hide protected operating system files” and make sure that is “unticked”.

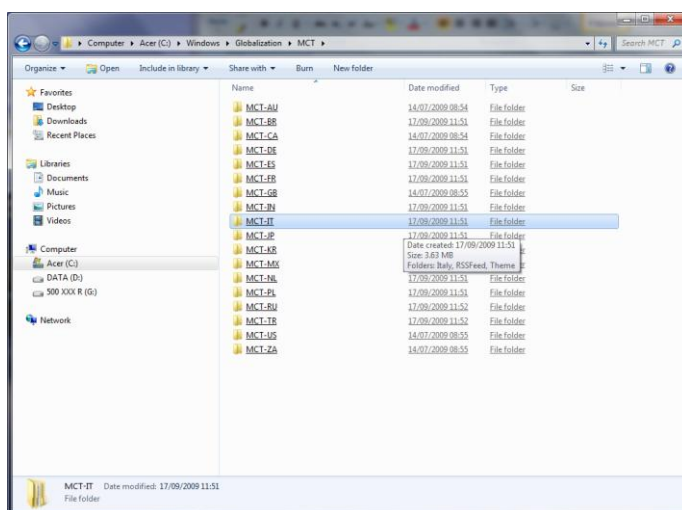

Click “Yes” on the pop-up screen

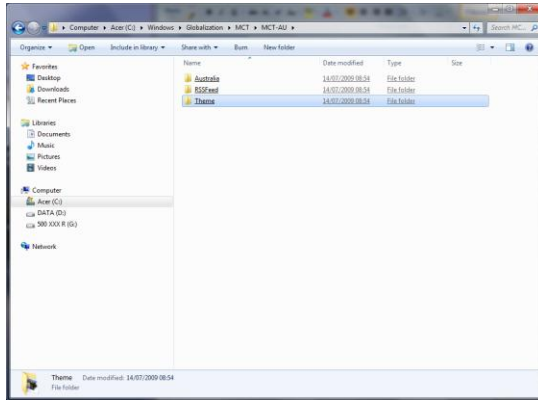


6. Click Apply and OK
7. Now open the C drive and the “Windows” folder
8. Look for a folder called “Globalisation” and within that one called “MCT”
9. In there you will see folders for different regions

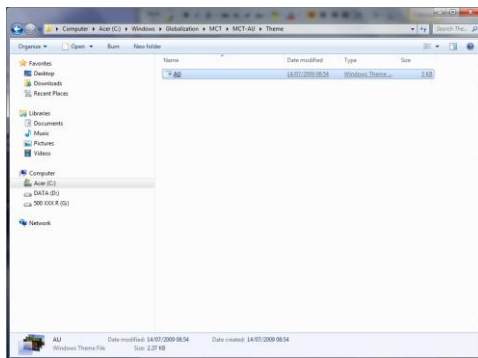


10. Open one of them and then click the “Theme” folder

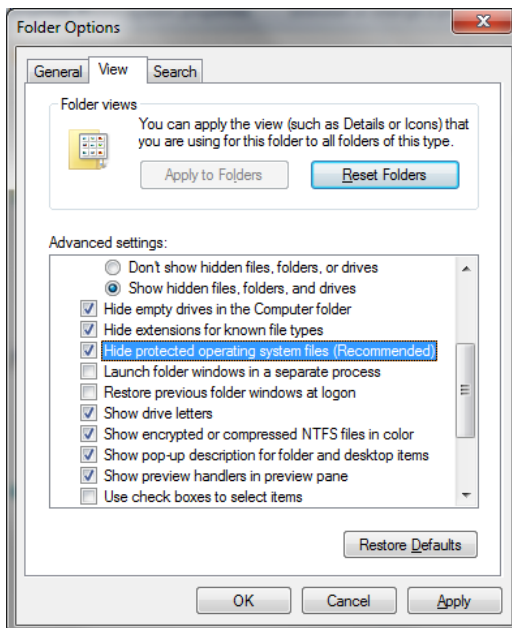

and double click the theme inside that.



11. Repeat step 10 for each of the other countries that you have
12. Go back to steps 2 through to 6 and untick the “Show hidden files” option and, **most importantly**, go down to “Hide protected operating system files” and make sure that is “ticked”
